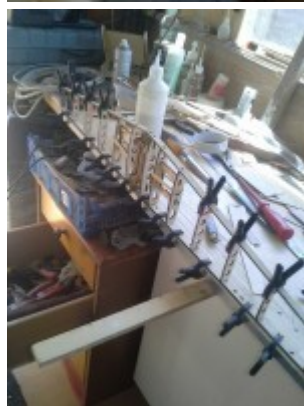
That looks like it is going together very nicely. Cracking build, like the way you are clamping and jiggging to keep everything straight and true.

All 0.8mm sheeting added to basic fuselage structures. I decided to use CW's method of planking the top nose sections. I've yet to add car filler to the ply but it does look promising so far.

You must all forgive me but I have lost the initial photos of the fuselage construction. I will pick the build up at the point of the fuselage sheeting. And Yes I am building Two. The stringer and formers were constructed over the wooden pieces extending from the side of my bench. All alignment was done with a drawn centreline on these wooden fingers. Both fuselages were at the glue drying stage at about 4 hours assembly of each.
