Howdy all well I didn't quite achieve what I set out too yesterday but what I did do I am definitely happy with and that being one completed tailplane and horizontal stab fully covered and ready for paint. But before painting there was one nagging point that ruind a nice model..... way oversized hinge slots, the solution is simple and involves filling the gap with scrap balsa, plane and sand while still allowing 45 degrees movement in either direction. Incidentally the model has some pretty cool design features, like the knuckle hinges brass bushing of the carbon hinge rod and general lightweight and sturdy construction.
