


BROBURN WANDERLUST

SINGLE PLANE 3-SEAT COUNTY SAILPLANE

This was a diminutive sailplane designed and built by Messers Brown and Burns in 1946 at Woodley aerodrome near Reding. It is believed to be languishing in a hangar at Farnborough awaiting restoration? Its wing span is only 10.36m. The wing profile at the root is NACA 23021 (which was exactly that of the original King Kites) but has NACA 4312 profile at the tip. Empty weight was only 250 lbs. Stalling speed was only 52kph (32.4 mph)
