Hi Geoff

I am trying something new on this model. The finish is just stained wood with no paint but to strengthen the model all the sheeted areas have been stained the correct shade and then will be glassed with a 49g twill and epoxy resin (yuck !). It is a particular resin that is very clear, it hides the weave on curing so the twill can't be seen. I have seen some European models done this way and the twill adds good strength with little weight build up which is important on a big model like the Wien. The alternative would have been to use thicker ply which is heavier and more difficult to form around the curves.

The Twill and resin is expensive, over £350 for enough to cover the model so I hope it works !!....we will find out shortly !?

You can easy buy this ply from Heerdegen Balsaholz in Germany.(I have ordered a few sheets early this year this way)

It comes rolled in a firm box 1.5 m long.

It can be so that he cuts of 2 cm for the 1.5 m P&P box...over 1.5 m the costs go up high...

I can help out when the German is a problem...did this a few times.

I buy my ply from Avon Plywood which is can be found at <http://www.avonplywood.co.uk>. the only thickness they do not sell is 0.6mm and for this the only supplier I know off is SLEC but they only have it in stock occasionally so when I know they have it I buy in bulk but it is not cheap !!!!

The national shortage may be due to my Wien project as so far it has used up 15 sheets of 4ft x 4ft x 0.6 ply and 5 sheets of 0.8mm !
