Ok so I havn't posted pics for a while as I havn't been building for a while.....too much work and desperately in need of sleep!

So here you go, Tonight I fixed the sheeting where my fingers went through it while putting the model together for a large model inspection the other night. Closer inspection revealed very soft balsa that had been sanded wrather thinly during sanding of the leading wedge, easy fix add glass cuffs before the covering goes on where you push the wings together has anyone else eperienced this yet Hmmm. So I looked a little closer, my sheeting has started to split in a couple of spots too and was easily fixed with some left over resin followed buy lightweight filler while wet, as the putty dries it soaks up the resin and hardens the assembly up, no real problem but your not supose to have to do that are you?

For some reason the wrather nice canopy frame has three ply cross braces where the pilot goes, easily fixed with a 4" grinder and some sand paper, while I was at it the servo tray in the nose also got the chop leaving just enough room for 2 x 5 cell sub C NMH batteries and a servo in the middle ( I still have to finish that. My pilot now has leg room and the fuse and canopy frame are still nice and stiff. And all this in 3 1/2 hours work..... a few more and I should be able to start covering, fingers crossed.
